The Construction Scotland Innovation Centre postgraduate programme 2016/2017 focused on preparing graduates for a career in the construction industry of tomorrow, aligning student's projects & research to the challenges of a modern construction industry delivering a low carbon built environment.

Project

The programme supported 16 student scholarships during 2016-2017 which were spread geographically across four HEI's covering a wide range of disciplines including Structural Engineering, Civil Engineering, Architectural & Building Performance, Water & **Environmental Management and Construction** Project Management. CSIC have received confirmation of the 2017/18 award and will actively encourage other university partners to apply for funding to support students in a range of disciplines. It is the ambition of the programme to ensure all students are aligned with a relevant industry partner to enable full collaboration and input to their research project.

Outputs

The programme offers:

- A flexible platform for industry to play an active role in supporting student's research
- Addresses key challenges faced by Scottish construction companies
- Increases student's engagement with industry through the course of their studies
- Provides students with relevant industry work experience as part of their MSc Programme
- Encourages new talent into Scotland's constructions industry
