

# BIM In Practice Programme

## Opportunity

The use of Building Information Modelling (BIM) requires companies working on a project using BIM to work more collaboratively and adopt more sophisticated digital technology, From April 2017 The Scottish Government has mandated that all public sector contracts over £2m be BIM Level 2 compliant. Ensuring Scotland's construction supply chain remains competitive and is able to engage with these projects also opens up a global market forecast to be worth £9bn by 2022.

## Project

This extensive programme delivered by CSIC and partners responds to this opportunity by a range of free awareness and implementation events, workshops and training, supported by an on-line advisory service.

## Outputs

- Increase BIM awareness across the Scottish construction industry and their supply chain.
- Greater use of BIM within construction projects.
- Wider adoption of digitisation within the Scottish construction industry.
- Enabling supply chain to engage with projects using BIM.
